Call for Abstracts

Presentations can be generated from any field of the human/social or natural/technical sciences. They are aimed at describing a **case study**, which could support the debate during the Symposium. Therefore, they should include either the description of a well established program, or of a well defined project bridging the gap between these sciences and cultures, or a report on identified problems related to a lack of dialogue. They should also include an appropriate evaluation of the results or a description of the evaluation tools.

Abstracts should include title, author(s) and their institution, and should not exceed 200 words. They will be reviewed by a Scientific Board, chaired by the Scientific Secretary.

The selected abstracts of case studies will be included in the general program as 5 min presentations, either in the discussion periods during the two main sessions, or during the workshops of the Symposium.

As a token of recognition, the Executive Committee will wave registration fees and hotel accommodation costs for the senior authors of the selected presentations.
